Embattled UN climate panel chief RK Pachauri also found support from world leaders attending the climate change conference in New Delhi as they contended that some mistake in the IPCC report does not change the basic facts of global warming. "Those who took delight in chastising the IPCC for its prediction on melting of glaciers by 2035 missed the point ... we in Bhutan feel and see for ourselves rapid change in the surroundings," Bhutanese PM Jigme Thinley said at the 10th Delhi Sustainable Development Summit here.
