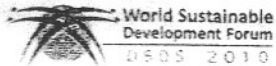

THE FIRST MAJOR GATHERING OF WORLD LEADERS AND EXPERTS POST COPENHAGEN

It would be the first major gathering of leaders drawn from every part of the globe and from every sphere of human endeavour to focus on the new pathways that the world is expected to explore and move along as a consequence of the post Copenhagen conference.

WORLD CEO FORUM

The major highlight of the Forum is the launch of the WBCSD Vision 2050 project. Recognising the increasingly important role played by the business sector in transforming the world economy, and its stakes in sustainable development, TERI-BCSD (Business Council for Sustainable Development) India, in association with the WBCSD, Geneva, is organising the World CEO Forum 2010 on February 4, 2010 at Hotel Taj Palace, New Delhi. The forum will focus on the overarching theme 'Vision for a Sustainable Tomorrow: Business as a Game Changer' discussing the sub themes: **Vision 2050- The New Agenda for Business:** Given the mega trends of population growth, urbanisation, climate change, and ecosystem decline, what kind of future is possible? What will it take to get there?

What are the challenges and opportunities? How should business lead? Initiated by 29 members of the World Business Council for Sustainable Development, Vision 2050 outlines answers to these questions, beginning with an ideal view-a world of 9 billion people living well, within the limits of the planet, in 2050. Vision 2050 describes new roles and relationships for business, government, and society that will help redirect the global commons toward a sustainable future. It opens a dialogue on coming changes in energy, transportation, human development, and other sectors along with the business opportunities these changes will create. And finally, Vision 2050 describes how the perennial strengths of business - innovation, customer focus, and strategic execution - will drive sustainable progress through the dynamic decades to come.

Over 200 CEOs, heads of multi/bi-lateral organisations and senior government representatives from across the globe would participate and address how they can help solve the climate crisis and stimulate 'green recovery' through innovative business models, effective policies and investments, new partnerships and development of energy-efficient technologies.
